


## **COVID-19 AUDITS**

Audits to obtain the COVID-19 safety certificate for applying the required safety precautions






The CDWS along with the MOTA representatives organized sudden spot-checks to inspect the operations, and also sudden campaigns to inspect the dive/snorkeling sites and jetties where the activities are performed, to ensure safety standards are applied.

The outcome of the spot checks was as follow:
